

## Bible Study Colossians

### Questions for Consideration

1. Does it matter whether Colossians was written by the Apostle Paul or not? Does authorship influence how one reads the letter, especially considering what the author says about those who should or should not be followed?
2. In speaking about the Supremacy of Christ in (vss. 15ff) the author makes a very bold statement; that “through him God was pleased to reconcile to himself all things.” What do you think that means?
3. Paul seems very concerned that the Colossians faith might become established in something other than the gospel. Is that still a real threat today? What sorts of things can people/we get caught up in that is not place our faith in Jesus and him alone?
4. Paul issues a warning in verse 28. What is that warning? What does a mature faith look like in your opinion?
